Who We Are

The University of Redlands is a comprehensive private university located in Redlands, CA. We serve over 4,000 students, including a small, residential liberal arts college, the Johnston Center for Integrative Studies, and the Schools of Business, Education and Continuing Studies.

Armacost Library is home to 7 librarians, 11 staff, and a collection encompassing more than 200,000 books and 400 serial and database subscriptions. Our public services are a vital source of outreach to students and faculty: in a typical semester we offer about 100 instruction sessions and field over 1500 reference questions.

The Instructional Services and First Year Experience Librarians seeks energetic, enthusiastic, creative interns to work with experienced instruction librarians on assessment and instruction activities, including working on a continuing 4 year longitudinal assessment project and developing online research guides and tutorials.

The University of Redlands was part of the first cohort for Assessment in Action, a nationwide assessment project supported by ACRL. We are starting our 3rd year of a 4 year longitudinal assessment project in Fall 2015.

What You'll Do

- Conduct a literature review on some aspect of information literacy instruction and/or assessment
- Present your research findings to the librarians.
- Create a LibGuide tailored to the needs of a specific course.
- Collect and/or analyze data related to a longitudinal study on student information literacy practices.
- Teach or co-teach a "one shot" information literacy session.
